

Conference Resolutions.

The following resolutions were passed at the semi-annual Conference of Waterloo County, Ontario, held on the 7th and 8th day of September, 1899. It was resolved:

1. "That Bro. Jonas B. Snyder shall have charge of the Snyder Church for one year from this date, assisted by Bro. Jacob S. Woolner."
2. "That the Brethren Jacob B. Gingrich and Eli S. Hallman, shall fill the appointments at Mosa for one year from this Conference."
3. "That this Conference advises that more simplicity be observed on funeral occasions."
4. That we fill appointments at the House of Industry every six weeks at 2:30 p. m.
5. That the request of the brotherhood at Akron, Michigan, to have service every four weeks, Communion twice a year, and have it entered in the Church Calendar, be granted."
6. Question: "What stand does this Conference take in regard to our sisters wearing hats?"
Answer: "The minister and the deacon in whose district such sisters reside shall visit them and report to the Bishop, and the Bishop shall act in conformity with God's Word."
7. That the church are to elect the brethren who are to collect the money for the Ministers' Fund."
8. "That this Conference favors the holding of a Bible Conference in the Canada Conference District."
9. "That the Brethren Noah Stauffer, Samuel S. Bowman and Eli S. Hallman be a committee to arrange for the holding of a Bible Conference."
10. "That this Conference will support the English services in Biehn and the North Woolwich districts, and the appointments shall be entered in the Church Calendar."
