n s t Modyford had represented the African Company's interests in Barbados. Moreover, one of the agents in Jamaica, Hender Molesworth, was appointed Lieutenant-Governor of the colony. On the death of Sir Thomas Lynch, he became the acting chief magistrate; and, in 1689, he was appointed Governor of the island.<sup>1</sup>
