ART. 9.—The name of every member failing the pay his annual subscription on the 1st of January, shall be exhibited in the Coffee Room on the 1st of February, if not then paid; and if the subscription be not paid on or before the 1st day of March following, the Secretary shall report accordingly to the Committee, who shall cause his name to be erased from the list of members; but he may be re-admitted by the Committee, upon assigning to them reasons which they shall consider satisfactory for his failure of payment.

Members failing to pay annual subscription.

ART. 10.—All entrance fees and annual subscriptions shall be paid to the Treasurer.

Paid to Treasurer.

ART. 11.—Any ordinary or privileged member, so long as the cause of privilege exists, who shall remove his residence to a greater distance than 60 miles from Ottawa (all his subscriptions then due being paid), may give notice to the Secretary of such removal, and of his intention not to make use of the Club thenceforward; and such Member shall cease to be liable to pay the yearly subscription of \$20, so long as he shall continue to reside at such distance from Ottawa; and such member shall at any time have the right of again using the Club by notifying his intention so to do, and paying the subscription for the then current year. But if any member so removing his residence from Ottawa, and taking advantage of this rule, shall again return to reside in Ottawa, or nearer than sixty miles therefrom, he shall, within one month from such return,
