THE WOMAN WAS MURDERED. Such Was the Verdict Returned by the Coroner's Jury at Galt in Case of Mrs. Cowan.

THE GUILTY PARTIES NOT KNOWN. Ontario Government Requested to Take Action With a View to Securing the Culprits.

Galt, Ont., March 29.—The adjourned coroner's inquest relative to the death of the late Mrs. William Cowan, who was found dead in her house on Pollock-avenue, last Tuesday morning, was resumed at 1:30 o'clock this afternoon before Coroner Bradford Galt and County Crown Attorney Bowdler of Berlin.

Deceased was last seen alive at 6 o'clock Sunday evening. Two men, who acted as if somewhat intoxicated, were seen at the gate of deceased's late residence at 11 o'clock Sunday night, one of whom was overheard remarking to his companion: "Now, be sure you don't say anything about this." To which the other consented: "These men moved down street on the approach of another man driving in a high speed motor car, for easy ingress into Cowan's house in a hurry about an hour later."

Another suspicious circumstance was that a window frame enough for easy ingress into the house, which, as a specific, was unusual in this case.

The jury brought in a verdict "that deceased came to her death by the hands of some person or persons unknown, and recommended that the Ontario Government be requested to take the necessary steps towards a further investigation of the matter."
