

Q—12. *When and where shall the next District Meeting be held? and by which of the General Committee Delegates shall each be attended?* **Ans.**

(1.) **TORONTO.**—At Hainstock's Chapel, Etobicoke Circuit on Wednesday, April 7th, 1858, E. Barrass, G. C. D.

(2.) **HAMILTON.**—At John Street Church, on Wednesday April 7th, 1858, W. Rowe, G. C. D. Each Meeting to commence at 9 o'clock in the morning.

Q—13. *What are the further Regulations of Conference?*

(1.) That on the evening preceeding the next Toronto District Meeting, Bro. T. Crompton, preach a Sermon on the mutual duties of the Ministers and Members of the Church.

(2.) That a general Camp Meeting be held in the vicinity of Kingston or Portland, in the month of June, under the direction of Bro. J. Lacey, and with the assistance of the Ministers on the eastern part of the Toronto District. Also one in the vicinity of Etobicoke or Markham, if practicable.

(3.) That the Brethren forming a Deputation from the Primitive Methodist Eastern Conference, United States, consisting of the Rev. C. Spurr, Mr. W. Donaldson, and Mr. T. Foster, be cordially accepted by this Conference; and that their credentials and statements be considered satisfactory.

(4.) That the Report of the Committee appointed to confer with the above mentioned Brethren, in relation to forming a fraternal union, be confirmed; and the duty of carrying out the necessary provisions of the Report, be given up to the General Committee.

(5.) That this Conference send a Deputation to the Eastern States Conference, if it can change the time of its session which is to be held in Brooklyn, N. Y. on the second week in April, 1858.

(6.) That each Station provide a proper chest or safe, in which to deposit its Chapel Deeds, and other Records; and that it be in the special care of the Superintendent Minister or Steward.

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
