THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY.

There are quite a number of supporters of the Meighen Government, many of them prominent in its counsels, who, while naturally regretting the defeat of that party at the polls, feel that if that defeat results in the thorough reorganization of the Conservative party, it may prove more of a benefit than otherwise. While Unionism had its advantages as it has adherents, the very name National Liberal and Conservative Party is a cause of offence; they want no hybrid organization of any kind. They feel that if the Conservative party is not virile enough to steer its own bark through the stormy waters of Canadian politics, without assistance from adherents of any other party, it may as well retire from the struggle.

The London Free Press puts the matter very bluntly when it says:—"If the Conservative party is to remain as a vital force in Canadian politics, there should be immediate arrangements for a Dominion-wide organization. The fortunes of the party were never so low as they are at the present time. Not only is there no provincial government held by the Conservatives, but they are now the third group in the Dominion Parliament.

"There may be many causes for this, but one of the chief is the fact that the Conservative party is a war casualty as much as any veteran Union Government was necessary for patriotic reasons. The winning of the war at the time was more important than the future of any party, but undoubtedly the formation of Union Government ruined temporarily the Conservative party. It broke up political organization and snuffed party loyalty. For four years the Cabinet ministers, engrossed in war of terror, forgot party politics and let the riding shift for themselves. The result could only be what has happened, despite the herculean and courageous efforts of Mr. Meighen."

The principles for which the Conservative party has stood in the past are still of vital necessity to the Dominion. If these principles are to be maintained then the party leaders should at once take steps to bring about a complete reorganization, and possibly to hold a Dominion convention. Although the party was beaten, yet not since 1911 has there been so much united fighting spirit in every province as Mr. Meighen has shown. Now is the time to crystallize this sentiment. If steps are not taken then the party is in danger of disappearing from the political map of Canada.

THE FOUR-POWER AGREEMENT.

The London Morning Post's opinion that the conclusion of an agreement between the four Great Powers, Britain, the United States, France and Japan, with a view to the perpetuation of a general peace, will be of more benefit than anything that has been done or can be done by the League of Nations, will, we imagine, be pretty generally concurred in throughout the civilized world. The proposed arrangement, it is true, applies only to problems arising in the Pacific but it strikes a chord that the nations have been waiting for for a long time. This agreement, if adopted, which there appears to be every chance of together with the other agreement for reduction of naval armaments, will achieve more than meets the eye.

The conclusion of an agreement such as is proposed should be of unusual interest to Canadians, for it absolutely endorses the stand taken by Premier Laurier at the London Conference last summer. He received from the beginning that however satisfactory the Anglo-Japanese Alliance made be from the British point of view, it could never be satisfactory to Canada, because of the danger that would always exist of the springing of a alliance with the United States. It is more to Canada's interests to remain on friendly terms with the neighbors to the South, than it is to be allied to Japan—although Canada will never wish to be on anything but friendly terms with that Empire—and there was always the danger that so long as Britain and Japan were hand-in-glove there would be a serious obstacle to the continuance of the friendly terms in case of any differences arising between the United States and Japan.

Mr. Meighen, of course, realized that however friendly Canada's relations with her neighbor might be, it was not desirable to fall out with Japan, but rather to conclude a new arrangement that should embrace both the United States and Japan. This is probably what has been done, with the addition that France is included as well.
