S. of W. J. Scott, Esq., M.D., of Prescott, Ont. B. there. Ed. at U.C. College. M. a dau. of the late John Heron, Esq., of Ottawa. Called to the Bar of U.C., Easter Term, 1848. Created Q.C., 1867. Is a mem. of the law firm of Scott, Ross & Stewart, Ottawa. A dir. of the Canada Central Railway. Has been Mayor of Ottawa. Elected Speaker of the Ont. Assembly, 7 Dec., 1871, but resigned on being apptd. a mem. of the Ex. Council and Commissioner of Crown Lands for that Province, on 21 of same month. Sat for Ottawa in Can. Assembly from 1857 to 1863, when defeated. Returned to present House at g.e., 1867. Re-elected at last g.e. and returned by acclamation on his appt. to office.
