An Act to amend The Lower Canada Game Act.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend chapter twenty-nine of the Con-Preamble.

solidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting Game and Hunting, so as to make further provision for the preservation of game and Stat. L. C.
wild animals, and for the better interpretation of certain clauses in the
said Act; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

- 1. In the first section of the said Act, the words "the first of March" Section 1 are substituted for "the first of February": excepting as hereinafter amended. provided.
- 2. It shall not be lawful for any person to hunt, kill or destroy any Hunting of red, grey, or fallow Deer, Moose, Elk, Reindeer, Caribou, nor the young deer in certain of any of the same, between the first day of January and the first day of September in every year, nor to buy, sell, offer for sale, or have in possession any of the above named species of animals, or any parts thereof, so taken within the period hereinbefore mentioned in this clause, in any of the counties or territory of Lower Canada, bordering upon the boundary line between the United States of America and British Canadian Territory.
- 3. The fifth section of the said Act is hereby repealed; except in as Section 5 re20 far as regards the district of Three Rivers, where it shall remain in full pealed.

 Exception.
- 4. The seventh section of the said Act, shall not apply to any wild Application animal or game, that is not specially mentioned by name in the said of section 7. Act, except as regards the use of poison, and except also that the said 25 section shall apply to grouse, partridge, snipe, and woodcock, so far as to prohibit the use of traps or snares in killing or taking them.
 - 5. It shall not be lawful, at any season, to kill, or take in any way, Killing in the grouse, partridge, snipe or woodcock, between sunset in the evening and night sunrise the next morning.
- 30 6. This Act shall be construed as one Act with the Act above cited; and any citation of or reference to The Lower Canada Game Act here. Interpreta-after made, shall mean the said Act as amended by this Act.
