exhibit the votes polled for the several candidates, if there be more than one candidate for cither of the said offices, and thereupon the Council shall proceed to determine and declare who are duly clected to the offcas of Reeve and Deputy Recve respectively; and, in case there shall have been more than one candidate for the said offices respectively, the candidate duly qualified and having the greatest number of votes for either of the said offices, shall be declared duls elected. If there be only one qualified candidate for either office, he shall be declared elected; and. if there be no sucla candidate, the office shall be declared racant and filled as heremafter provided.

Recers so 6. The Reeves ant Deputy Reeves so elected shall be Members of the elected to be mentbers of their Councils. Councils of the Municipalities in which they are respectively elested, and shall have the same powers and dutics as Councillors elected to be Reeves and Deputy Reeves, respectively now have by law.

In ease of ra. 7. In the case of a vacancy occurring in the office of Reeve or Deputy 15 cancy.

Reeve, the Council of the Municipality shall, by a vote of the majority thercof, elect a Reeve or Deputy Reeve, as the circumstances may require, from among themselves, to fill the vacancy until a successor shall be duly elected at the next annual election.

Contrary pro- 8. All the provisions of chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Sta- 20 visions. tutes for Upper Canada respecting the Manicipal Institutions of Upper Canada, which conflict with or are contrary to the provisions of this Act, are hereby repealed.
