

should be paid repairs out of the proceeds.

If His Excellency the Governor General should approve of this suggestion, I am of opinion that a further sum of from Two to Three hundred Pounds from the same source should be immediately expended to complete the necessary repairs to this important line of communication between Lake Simcoe and Lake Huron, for should a large emigration arrive in this country and the Government should desire to forward emigrants or they themselves desire to proceed to the new settlement at Amiens Sound they can reach their destination by this route from Holland Landing with only fourteen miles of land carriage instead of forty miles if they proceed or are sent by the way
