The Indian woman is alleged to have been shot after a home brew party in a shack on the lake on February 11. After the affray, Seymour is reported to have mounted a horse and escaped. Another Indian took after him but was ordered, at the point of a gun, to return, Seymour announcing that he was going to commit suicide.

Suicide is rare among Indians, police have found, and is only resorted to when the native finds his escape hopeless. It is believed Seymour has made for a hideout in the woods and provincial police will start a hunt for him.
