with the report from In-
for John Shirras, Kamloops,
out Seymour, an Indian wanted in
connection with the fatal shooting
of Mrs. Johnny Baptiste at White-
water Lake, had disappeared into
the woods.

The Indian woman is alleged to have
been shot after a home brew party in a
shack on the lake on February 11. After
the affray, Seymour is reported to have
mounted a horse and escaped. Another
Indian took after him but was ordered,
at the point of a gun, to return. Sey-
mour announcing that he was going to
commit suicide.

Suicide is rare among Indians, police
have found, and is only resorted to
when the native finds his escape hope-
less. It is believed Seymour has made
for a hideout in the woods and pro-
vincial police will start a hunt for him.
