Since the present government came into office, there have been twenty-five by-elections.

In the twenty-five by-elections:

Six Conservatives held constituency previously held;
One Social Credit held constituency previously held;
Of eighteen Liberal victories, sixteen held constituency previously held, and two were gains from Conservatives.

In ten by-elections the Government candidate was returned by acclamation (two were in Queen's, P.E.I., a two-member riding).

In one by-election (Dufferin-Simcoe) the Opposition Candidate was returned by acclamation.

No seat has been lost by the Government since the general election; Victoria, B. C., and Brandon have been gained.
