

6. Engineer Services.

Provision has been made for the further development of bases and establishments for the units of the Royal Canadian Air Force at various points across Canada. For the defence of the Atlantic Coast, provision has been made for the purchase of three (3) aerodrome sites, and one (1) intermediate landing ground, and the partial development thereof, and other minor services in Nova Scotia, for which \$435,000.00 has been included.

At Trenton, provision has been made for a Stores Building and Signal Training School for which there is now no accommodation; an additional Barrack Block for airmen; and a building for Airmen's Mess and Recreational facilities for the Station. In addition to the foregoing, allowance has also been made for a small hospital, and a permanent central heating plant for the Station. Other minor requirements here have also been taken care of. For these purposes \$747,550.00 has been included.

For Jericho Beach, Vancouver, allowance has been made for the construction of a Barrack Block, a Water Tower, a Signal Station, the Apron and fill in connection with the reclamation work now in progress, and the provision of other necessary services. For this an amount of \$310,000.00 has been included.
