Gentlemen,-

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th instant, advising the number of logs cut on the Hallow Water Reserve during last winter, namely:- 11,298 logs containing 268,159 feet, B. M.

The previous return for logs cut season of 1907 shows 14,289 logs containing 520,370 feet, B. M.

No report of the quantity cut during season of 1908 has been received.

I have, therefore, to request you to furnish without delay a sworn statement showing the number of pieces of logs and contents of same which were cut since in January, 1908, the first return was made, namely, during the seasons of 1908 and 1909 in accordance with the agreement made. Blank forms for returns have been sent to your address.
