

from a really deserving destitute Indian for relief and that all that you had to do was to state the circumstances to the Dept. which appeared to you to justify relief being given to cause the same to be supplied by cheque in the usual regular way.

As respects the provision of coffins for the dead, this of course where the Indians are quite unable to procure the same for themselves would be altogether an exceptional matter, as the dead must be buried with very little delay and the Dept. quite understands that in exceptional cases of that kind
