

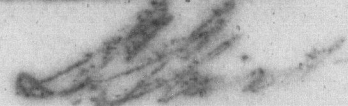
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Ottawa 25th August 1902

Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 19th instant enclosing a Resolution of the Cape Greber Council, asking that the non-treaty Indians living on the Front Road, who cannot be compelled to clear their paths of time on the road, be taxed and the amount charged against their improvements and that they be ordered to sell to members of the Band who cannot improve the highways, I have to ask that you will kindly advise the Department under what authority these non-treaty Indians hold lands on the Reserve.
