In reply to your letter of the 20th instant enclosing a Resolution of the Cape Creeks Council, asking that the half-breed Indians living on the Great Road, who cannot be compelled to give their quota of time on the road, be freed and the quota dropped against their improvements and that they be allowed to call to members of the band who cannot improve the highway, I have to ask that you will kindly advise the Department under what authority these half-breed Indians hold lands on the Reserve.
