In reply to your letter of the 2nd instant, regarding the application made by certain Indians at the head of Okanagan Reserve for seed, I beg to say that the Department is willing to supply seed to a reasonable extent to those Indians who are unable to supply same for themselves. When reporting in the matter you should have stated the kind and quantity of seed required. Only those Indians who prepare their land for sowing, and who are likely to care for their crops when growing should be assisted.
