I beg to inform you that the Department has appointed Dr. Robb, of Blind River, to attend Indians of the Serpent River and Mississauga River Reserves. Copy of the letter informing him of his appointment is enclosed herewith.

Dr. W. B. Sproule, of Massey, is also being appointed to attend Indians of the Spanish River Reserve. A copy of the letter addressed to him in the matter is transmitted herewith.

You should place ~~at~~ the names of both doctors on your pay-list and make requisition for their salary regularly in future.

It will be your duty to forward to the Department at the close of each month a report from both doctors regarding Indian work done. If you do not receive the reports regularly, you should make request for them, as you will be responsible for their transmission to the Department.
