Ottawa, January 28, 1915.

Madam,-

I have to auknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant with reference to the building utilized by you for the purpose of carrying on a day school at Andimaul.

With regard to your request that the Department pay for the rent of this building I beg to say that it will pay a sum of \$8.00 per month for this purpose. The owner of the building should, however, make the few repairs that are required. Mr. Agent loring will be informed of the Department's intention to provide for the payment of rent for the building occupied by you and he will be instructed to forward vouchers for the payment thereof at the end of each quarter.
