
## Commonwealth Parliamentarians' Conference

The Biennial General Conference of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association was held in Canberra, Australia, from November 3 to November 7, 1959. The Canadian Delegation, led by the Hon. Roland Michener, Speaker of the House of Commons, was composed of eight federal and five provincial delegates. The Federal delegates included Senators D. Smith and G. S.
