# Stock Exchange Notes.

Thursday, December 7, 1911.

Montreal Power was again the leader in an otherwise uninteresting market, and on sales of some 5,400 shares, reached a new high record of 188 1/2, closing at a reaction of less than a point from the highest, and showing a net gain of almost three points for the week. Cement stocks were the other prominent factors and both show fractional gains on a fair turnover. The usual holiday spirit seems to have taken possession of the market, and it is not thought that any decisive move, one way or the other, will be seen, but the undertone is strong. No selling pressure is in evidence, money seems to be easing, and the outlook is for an active and advancing market. Some of the unlisted common stocks are favorably considered, notably Spanish River, Dominion Canners and Sherwin-Williams. It is thought that a purchase of any one of these stocks, for a patient holder, will be advantageous. Canadian Pacific has re-acted after its long period of advance and there is a decline, ex-dividend, of the equivalent of three points on a very small volume of sales. "Soo" common is also lower, showing a decline of two points. Montreal Street, while not very active, was a strong point and closes four points up with 229 bid. The market as a whole was narrow. The Bank of England rate remains unchanged.
