FAIR & BATES

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS. A. P. Bates, head of a family, or any male over 18 years old may homestead a quarter section of available land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may file a claim on a quarter section of land on a farm of at least 80 acres situated on the same section as the land to be homesteaded. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Before the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent), and cultivate 20 acres extra.
