A BY-LAW. Authorizing the issue of Debentures by the Municipality of Goderich, to the amount of \$2500, for purposes therein set forth.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Goderich is at present indebted to several parties, for work done, to the amount of four hundred pounds; and whereas the Board of Common School Trustees, have required of the said Municipal Council, the sum of six hundred pounds for the erection of new School houses; and with which demand, the Council deem it expedient to comply; and whereas the Council have taken stock in the Montreal Gravel Road Company, to the amount of two hundred and fifty pounds; and have also received to grade and gravel certain of the principal streets in the town, and to make other local public improvements within the town; at a cost of the amount of five hundred and fifty pounds; and whereas it is necessary to raise an equal sum, as and after the passing of the said By-Law, and in addition to all other rates, the following sums, that is to say: in the year 1854, the sum of \$75; in the year 1854, 1855, 1856, 1857, the sum of \$150; and in the year 1858, the sum of \$250; and whereas the amount of the whole of the said debt, is \$2500; and whereas for the financial year preceding the passing of this By-Law, was \$2703 1/2, and whereas for the payment
