CEYLON'S ISLAND.

THE LAWS, CUSTOMS AND INDUSTRIES OF THE INHABITANTS.

Native Products of the Island-Ceylon Cinnamon-Cocoa Palm Tree-Coffee Plantations Ruined by the "Vast-of-Tricks."

The Tea Industry. Ceylon now pays its own military expenses, the force being only one regiment of British infantry, one of native and one brigade of artillery.

The abolition of slavery was finished about forty years ago. Less than thirty years ago polyandry (many husbands) was legal.

Government, from time to time, according to the will of the different governors, clear away overgrowth and excavate out of debris and earth the still remaining architecture of a civilization which ranks among the most interesting of ancient ruins.

The native people could raise plantation and garden products-pepper, cinnamon, nutmeg, chocolate, cardamoms and fruit-sell them dear, and sell rice cheap from India and Burmah.

More attention is now given to the various palms. Many forebushes, Singaleses and Tamils, whose thrift also is within the last fifty years, now plant gardens of palms and other profitable trees as an investment.

Every Singalesse garden grows a little sugar cane, usually to be chewed like candy. There is only one large manufacturing sugar estate in Ceylon.

The Arab introduced the coffee plant very anciently, yet its beverage was unknown when the European arrived.

Meaning a small bright orange spot appeared on the coffee leaves, yet slightly affecting the plant. Nobody cared for it except the director of the Ceylon Botanic gardens.
