

Dr. McKay, opened the meeting, and in an eloquent speech of upwards of an hour reviewed the record of the Mowat Administration. At the conclusion of his speech the chairman, Mr. B. B. Miller, asked for anyone who wished to speak for Mr. George, when Mr. Jermyn, the reeve of Wiarton, came upon the platform and was granted an hour. Mr. Mabee, who was received with great applause, then addressed the meeting. The castigation Mr. Jermyn received at his hands will not soon be forgotten by those who heard it.
