NO CHANGE MADE IN SUNDAY OBSERVANCE

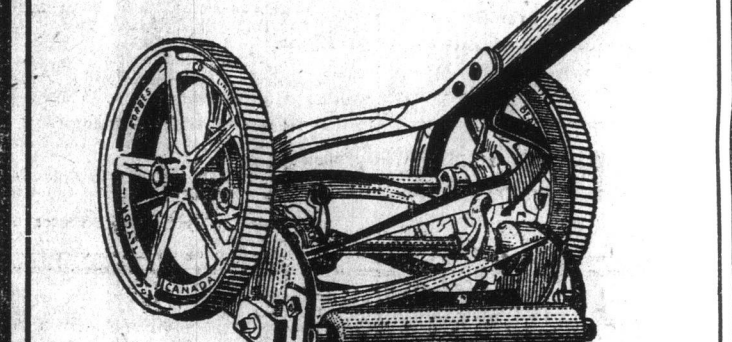
