### Gunner Allan, Charged With the Crime, Had Threatened to Kill Officer But Was Not Taken Seriously

Murdered in cold blood, Capt. Peter Elliston, officer commanding No. 9 Co., R. C. A., has died as a result of the Work Point barracks, and Gr. Thomas Allan, No. 6957, who cowardly lay in wait at an upper window of the barracks until his victim left the company office, directly opposite his hiding place and shot him down, is held at the provincial gaol charged with the murder. Brooding over a sentence for which 10 days was remitted because of King George's general pardon at his accuser's plea, making threats against Capt. Elliston, Allan had done so Corriegan that Capt. Elliston had done him an injustice and added: "I've a bullet for him and it will find his billet." Allan had told his wife which he had secreted, and had his rifle loaded waiting until the opportunity came, as he expected, when Capt. Elliston went, as was his custom, at 9 a. m., to the company office.
