 FARINA PUDDING.—Boil one pint milk; add one-half cup farina, one-half cup of sugar and one tablespoonful of butter. Cook half an hour, cool slightly, then add yolks of four eggs. When cold add three tablespoonfuls milk and one teaspoonful vanilla, and stir in the beaten whites of four eggs; coat some buttered tin moulds with sugar and fill in the pudding; let stand for ten minutes, then bake three-quarters of an hour. Serve with sauce.
 SWEETBREADS EN BROCHETTE.—A very good way of serving this most excellent dainty. Small sweetbreads are just as good as large, and being very much cheaper are recommended for made dishes. Before using them, always parboil them in hot water a few moments, skin and trim them neatly. Then they are ready for cooking. Scientific and Useful.

TO REMOVE INK STAINS.—Ink stains in cotton or linen can often be removed by washing in salt and water; while wet they can be taken out with vinegar or milk without injury to colour or fabric; but either of these methods must be employed before the fabric is washed with soap, or even wet with water.

SCALLOPED CORN AND TOMATOES.—Mix together half a can of each; stew for half an hour with a tablespoonful of butter, scant teaspoonful of sugar, and salt and pepper by way of seasoning. Put in a buttered dish, strew thickly with bread crumbs, and dot with bits of butter. Bake for half an hour, and serve hot in the same dish.

PORRIDGE.—You cannot cook porridge too much. It should be like thick batter when poured out, not the lumpy dough one is used to seeing under the name of oatmeal porridge on the breakfast table. Always cook in a vessel set within another, the outer containing boiling water. Burnt or scorched porridge is peculiarly disagreeable to taste and smell.

EGG FRITTERS.—Beat up some eggs and season them as for a plain omelette; throw in some slices of bread about one-third of an inch thick—old bread will answer; let them soak for a quarter of an hour; then fry them in oil or butter as fritters, and when they become of a yellow colour serve them very hot; salt and grated cheese sprinkled over improve them.

ALMOND CAKE.—Take three eggs with their shells, weigh the same weight of flour, of fresh butter and white sugar, beat to a paste three ounces of sweet almonds, mix them with the creamed sugar and butter, add the eggs beaten separately, and then the flour; a few drops of essence of bitter almonds improves this. Pour the cake batter into a buttered mould, and bake in a gentle oven.

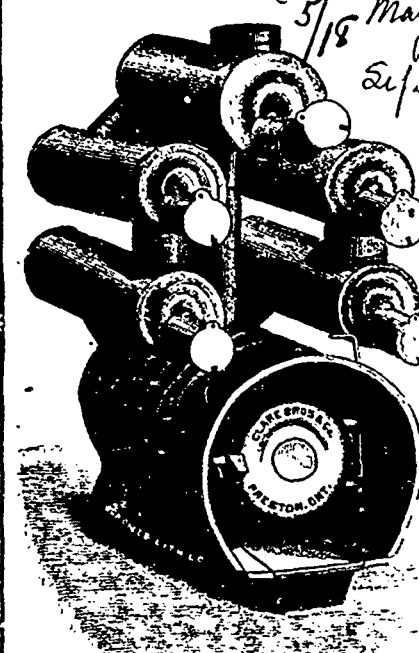
