

ALMOND CAKE.—Take three eggs with their shells, weigh the same weight of flour, of fresh butter and white sugar, beat to a paste three ounces of sweet almonds, mix them with the creamed sugar and butter, add the eggs beaten separately, and then the flour; a few drops of essence of bitter almonds improves this. Pour the cake batternto a buttered mould, and bake in a gentle oven.

When cold add three tablespoonfuls milk and one teaspoonful vanula, and stir in the beaten whites of four eggs; coat some buttered tin moulds with sugar and fill in the pudding; let stand for ten minutes, then bake three-quarters of an hour. 
