The last deceased painter was born in 1825, of English parents, at Andelys (Eure), and his student days were not altogether exempt from the privations and proportional misery that usually attend upon professional pride or the consciousness of innate merit, that most individuals encounwho look forward to fame.

Until his fatal illness, by congestion of the lungs, Chaplin preserved joviality of demeanour, and humour of repartee, which, combined with his truly British appearance of robust vigour, and hearty frank manners, were strangely at variance with the vaporous-not to say sensual--reproductions of female beauty, no de or en demi toilette, that signalised his brush as the modern successor on canvas to the old French masters, Watteau and Boucher, in the same styles A characteristic remark, repeated by the Figure, is a real index to the character and inclinations of the late Charles Chaplin, who one day told an intimate friend-" See here, I believe hard work, the seaside, and tea, are the three bases of perfect health!"


