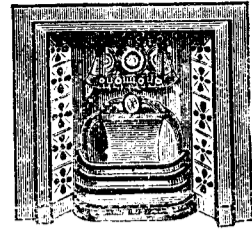

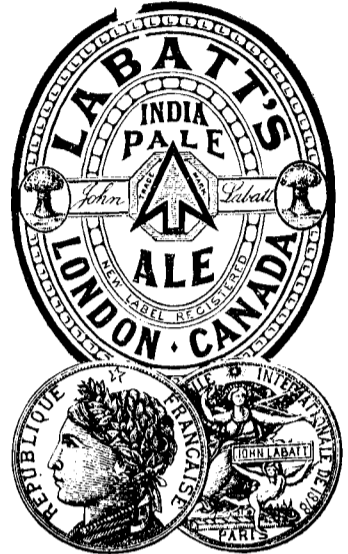


BRASS FIRE SETS. Coal Grates.
