

On the coming into force of the present treaty it shall supersede all other existing provisions of treaties and conventions relating to extradition between Canada and the United States of America.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the above-named plenipotentiaries have signed the present treaty and have hereunto affixed their seals.

DONE in duplicate at Washington this twenty-ninth day of April, 1942.

The arrest and extradition under the provisions of this treaty shall be carried out in Canada and in the United States of America, respectively, in accordance with the laws and regulations of each country.

ARTICLE XIII
All expenses connected with the extradition shall be borne by the requesting country. However, the appropriate legal officers of the requested country where the proceedings of extradition are had, shall, consistently with the discharge of their duties and without charge, cooperate with the officers of the requesting country, before the respective judges and magistrates, in the examination and trial of the accused.

ARTICLE XIV
The present treaty shall be ratified by the high contracting parties in accordance with their respective constitutional methods and shall take effect on the day after the exchange of ratifications which shall take place at Washington as soon as possible.
