Matthew R. Dale, Gentleman of His Holiness Yvon Beaulne, Canadian Ambassador to the Holy See Raymond Beaugrand, Quebec Delegate to Milan.

Bishop de Montmorency-Laval was the first Canadian bishop with a diocese which covered the whole North American continent.

Mother Marie de l'Incarnation established the Ursuline in Canada, the first religious order for women in this country, and devoted her efforts to the schooling of Indians.

An Iroquois, Katéri Tekakwitha, was a dominant figure in the early history of the Church in New France.
