MOTION TO CONVENE STANDING COMMITTEE

**Mr. Allan Lawrence (Northumberland-Durham):** Mr. Speaker, the House will recall that earlier this afternoon a question of privilege was raised by the hon. member for Fort William (Mr. McRae). His words certainly fell on sympathetic ears on this side of the House. They related to the apparent duplication of work between a standing committee of this House and an agreement tabled yesterday by the Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources (Mr. Gillespie).

I would request through you, Mr. Speaker, leave of the House to present the following motion, seconded by the hon. member for Fort William:

That the Standing Committee on National Resources be convened as soon as the Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources is available to attend to examine into and report upon the agreement tabled in this House yesterday, June 5, between Atomic Energy (Canada) Limited and Ontario Hydro and the duplication between the work of the committee and the conclusions apparent in the agreement.
