But talking about money and about salaries

there is one precedent that our critics have

forgotten, which is the more strange since it

comes from Plato and would apply directly to those

professors among us who think that the mantle of

Plato or Aristotle has falken descended upon them.

This precedent consists in the regulation laid down

for the philosophers by Plato in his ideal Republic 
that they should not accept gold or payment of any

kind, because as he said, wie the world would

recognize the gold in their characters and would

bring them all that they needed.
