## Rules of Order; or, Order of Proceedings.

- 1. As soon as the Presiding Officer has taken the chair, the officers and members present shall take their respective places, and the Lodge shall then be opened in due form. The Lodge shall be opened at 8 p.m. and closed at 10 p.m. The order of proceedure shall be as follows:—
- a. Tyler, are you satisfied all present are members of this Association.
  - b. Calling roll of officers.
  - c. Reading minutes of previous session.
  - d. Reports of Committee on Candidates.
- e. Balloting for if so demanded, and initiation of Candidates.
  - f. Reading of correspondence.
- g. Unfinished, new, and general business.
  - h. Proposals for membership.
