APPEN-DIX. I PRAY that the energy, the vigour, and the humanity; which you have so honourably displayed, may descend to your children; and secure to them for ever, those blessings which you have hitherto enjoyed, under the mild and happy government of the illustrious House of Hanover.

IT must not be omitted (though I mention it with great concern) that Major-General Walpole, being distatisfied with the resolution of the Legislature to transport the Maroons from the country, declined the acceptance of the sword voted by the Assembly.
