All Subdivisions.

In through freight or passenger service on engines (other than mallet type) weighing 215,000 lbs. and over on drivers, a defferential of 25 cents per day higher than the next highest rate in the same class of service.

Special Services.

Deadhead on Company's orders; 200 miles or less minimum passenger rates actual mileage.

Distance in excess of 200 miles—one half minimum passenger rates.

A firemen deadheading will be paid a minimum of a day's pay at minimum passenger rates, but will be liable for further service to the extent of ten hours.

It is agreed that oil burning engines in freight, mixed work, gravel, wreck, pusher, snowplow and branch service (except mallet engines) will be paid 15 cents less per 100 miles than the rates in this schedule.
