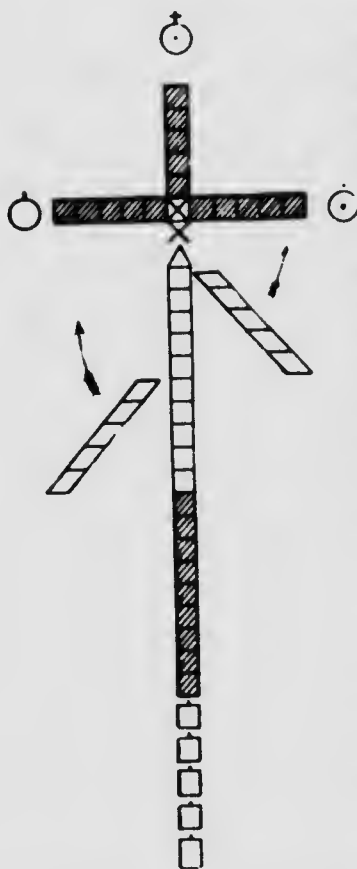


163.— Being Either in Line or Column to Form Passion Cross.



Form—Passion Cross.—The preceptory being on the march either in line, column of half preceptories, sections or squads, the Captain-General will give the command, advance in file from the right *right—turn, left—wheel*; the whole will form into file, col. party conforming and following No. 2 section (if necessary the Captain-General may cause the preceptory to number from the front). Captain-General then commands FORM PASSION CROSS, when leading section will mark time, No. 2 section will make a right incline, forming up on right of rear man of No. 1 section; No. 3 section will make a left incline, forming up on the left of rear man of No. 1 section, the color party will advance; the Sir Knight carry-

ing the National color will place himself as the centre point of the two arms; the Sir Knight carrying Beauseant will follow in file forming part of the stem; No. 4 section will advance in file joining on to beauseant, and forming stem of cross. The Captain-General will place himself at head, senior subalterns on outer point of right arm, junior subalterns on outer point of left arm, other commanders falling in in the stem, the adjutant in rear of all.
