BY-LAW NO. 864.

By-Law to appoint High School Trustees.

Whereas by 23 Vic., Chap. 50, Sec. 18, Councils are empowered to make appointments to fill vacancies arising from the annual retirement, resignations or otherwise, of High School Trustees.

Iroquois—No. 5, William Whittaker, North Williamsburgh.

BY-LAW NO. 865.

By-Law to appoint a Board of Audit for the year 1889.

Under and by virtue of Sections 513 of the Municipal Institutions Act of the Province of Ontario, the Corporation of the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry.

1st—That James Fraser, Esq., of Loch Garry, and Adam Harkness, Esq., Iroquois, be, and they are hereby appointed members of the Board of Audit for the current year.
