

FINANCE REPORT.

For the Year 1867.

TO THE WARDEN AND COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF ELGIN:—

The Standing Committee on Finances, beg leave to Report:

That your Committee having carefully examined into the financial affairs of the County, and the estimate submitted by the County Treasurer, herewith submit an estimate of the expenditure required to be provided for the lawful purposes of the County, during the Current Year, showing amounts to be raised for the undermentioned purposes, namely:—

Debentures and Interest,	\$2,818.
Municipal Loan Fund,	6,400.
Common Schools,	3,489.
Grammar Schools,	600.
Local Superintendents,	500.
Board of Public Instruction,	400.
Administration of Justice, and Jurors,	4,000.
General Purposes, Members' Wages, &c.,	5,283.
Grants for County Roads and Bridges,	500.
Registrar's Fees, Books &c.,	1,200.
Drill Sheds,	1,000.
	\$26,050.

Your Committee have carefully examined the above estimate, and find that the several amounts therein are required as low as practicable, without affecting the credit of the County.

Your committee therefore recommend, that the sum of Twenty-six Thousand and Fifty Dollars, be raised in the several Municipalities in the County, as per Schedule herewith; and, that the requisite By-Laws be drawn up and passed in accordance therewith, to levy a Rate of Six Tenths of a Cent in the Dollar, on the rat cable property in the County, to raise said amount, as follows:—
