

At a Meeting of the Rev. the Clergy Corporation on the 8th February, 1831, the following Resolution was moved by the Right Reverend the Lord Bishop of Quebec, and adopted:—

Resolved—That it being expedient that the By-Laws be revised and amended, and some additional By-Laws be adopted, a Committee of three persons be chosen for revising the present By-Laws, and suggesting such alterations in them, and additions to be made to them, as to such Committee shall seem fit, to be by them submitted to a General Meeting of the Board, next Summer; and that the Archdeacon of York, the Rev. A. N. Bethune, and the Rev. J. Miller. be appointed a Committee for this purpose; and that a copy of the present By-Laws be printed, and sent to each Clergyman of the Province, requesting such suggestions as may seem to them necessary for their improvement.
