Strong interests in the market will help along the advance, and if the bad reports continue there will be a big increase in outside buying. With these conditions, we are inclined to advise purchases on all setbacks, as shorts will be likely to cover on any further advance. Lecount says even with rains there will be a repetition of North Dakota conditions of last year in South Dakota this season.
