Mass Meeting of Servants Ask for  
Commercial Treaty With Bulgaria

Belgrade, Jan. 27.—At a mass meet-  
ing of delegates from all parts of Servia,  
which was held here to-day to protest  
against the action of Austria in clos-  
ing the frontier to the importation of  
Serbian goods, resolutions were passed  
urging support to the Servian gov-  
ernment in its efforts to bring about  
commercial union with Bulgaria.

A mob assembly demolished the premises  
of the St. Stampa, the only  
newspaper opposing the convention,  
which is the cause of the present rift  
between Austria and Servia.

**Arrested to Recover Judgment**  
New York, Jan. 27.—Charles Wenham of Chicago, the former general western passenger agent for the Canadian Pacific Railway Co., Atlantic Steamship Line, was arrested in civil proceedings to-day and sent to jail in default of \$40,000 bail. His arrest was made in connection with an attempt to recover judgment for \$54,78, which was rendered against him in Chicago.
