103 Rue Reaumer, Paris, May 16, 1910.—The short dress has taken Paris by storm. One year ago it would have been thought impossible that the great couturieres of the Rue de la Paix would have sanctioned such an innovation. While for some years past the wearing of this most comfortable style of dress was accepted for morning only, to-day its reign is absolute for all afternoon functions as well, for, in fact, everything, except dinners and French taste, the outcome of gen-

erations of fashion-makers. We are indebted to our English cousins primarily for the trotteur. The French, having accepted it, have gone them not only one better, but a thousand better, so far as weirdness is concerned. And yet, notwithstanding all the deserved criticism of the painfully narrow skirts, that scarcely permit a natural walk, there is something unexplainably chic and pert in the much-discussed costumes. The low-cut neck lends itself more particularly to French women, who have short throats, but the high collar is equally fashionable.

In a very fetching Rue de la Paix creation 'twould be hard to describe the beauty of coloring that makes a harmonious whole. The body of the dress is a soft periwinkle blue voile Ninon, gathered with a shaped black satin band. The waist is of the usual kimono effect, draped skilfully over the arms. The particularly chie touch is found in the silver-embroidered flesh-colored band that squarely surrounds the rounded guimpe of silver net. The bow on front of the corsage is of black tuile, held in the centre by a tiny strasse ornament.

Glimpses of silver embroidery appear on the sleeves. An impertinent black satin belt is connected with the band on the botton by a narrow scarf of black satin, terminating at either end by black satin chrysanthemums.

We were privileged to see the hat that went with this costume, which was really a marvel of picturesque simplicity. It was made of flesh-colored crin, lined with black satin, its only trimming being a huge bow of black net.
