TROUBLE BREWING

IN SOUTH AFRICA

Smuts Says Foolish Talk of Whites is Putting Ideas Into Heads of Blacks.

Pretoria, South Africa, Feb. 23.—Lieut.-General Jan Christian Smuts, British member of the league of nations commission, in a speech here today referred to native troubles in the Witwatersrand gold mine fields, which he characterized as dangerous.

Between 30,000 and 40,000 blacks are striking. Gen. Smuts said, and by means of organized picketing are doing things which he would have considered them incapable of doing. The speaker declared he had seen
