## Free Church of England.

The beginning of an important movement in the right direction.

The new Free Church at Exeter was opened in May, 1846, for the first time, when service, according to the rites of the Church of England, was performed. The church is to be totally independent of the Bishop of Exeter, or any other ecclesiastical jurisdiction. The Royds. Robert Cowie and James Shore, both ministers of the Church of England, officiated on the occasion. Subsequently another was opened in London under a Dr. Dillon, and now there are already five or six Independent Congregations of this kind. This is the sure remedy for ecclesiastical corruption.
