## SESSION II.

## DIET I.

James Ketchan, and Rev. William Rintoul, *Ministers*: and Mr. John McLean and Mr. Andrew McCord, *Ruling Elders*. Mr. Machar being called to the chair, opened the meeting with prayer, and Mr. Rintoul was chosen Clerk to the meeting.

It was unanimously resolved to put it on record, that the individuals constituting the present meeting, have met this day, first at Twelve o'clock, noon, and now again, together with the Rev. Robert McGill and the Rev. George Sheed, at Six o'clock, P. M., whilst the Moderator of the Synod has not been present, and that the meeting recognize their right to constitute the Synod, yet defer doing so till to-morrow at Ten o'clock, A. M.

The meeting was closed with prayer.
